The premiere of “Buddy Guy, The Blues Chase The Blues Away”

Bluesworks by Earl has been chosen as sole artist to have his blues history paintings to assist Buddy Guy in telling his lifelong legacy in this new PBS documentary. There are 42 of Earl's paintings used in the making of this film!

The film will make its broadcast premiere on PBS, on July 27 2021, as part of the prestigious, long-running "American Masters" series.

Directed by Scheme's own Devin Amar, Chas Todd, and Matt Mitchener, the documentary captures the story of Buddy Guy, who transcended his early years sharecropping in 1940s Louisiana to become one of music's influential guitarists, directly inspiring The Rolling Stones, Jimmy Page, and Eric Clapton. A tale of decades-long perseverance, Buddy's journey reflects both the black experience in American in the twentieth century and the history of the blues.
